******Please Note:**

- 1.) Students who are also interested in taking choir may take Concert Choir along with Concert Band during freshman year (alternate band/choir every day).
- 2.) Students may select from many different class choices within the school requirements, including regular and honors/AP level courses.
- 3.) The plans listed here show 4 years of all 5 core classes. Many students choose not to take either a social studies or foreign language for one of the years in order to create a free period in their schedule that may be used to fulfill elective graduation requirements or to take another elective. Some students may also take a class in summer school to free a period during the school year.
- 4.) Graduation requirements include a fine art, consumer education, and drivers education credit that may be fulfilled through different class combinations or summer school. Obviously, the fine art requirement is fulfilled by participation in music.
